Day1:[Childhood](#) [Luke 2:7, 40, 52](#) - She gave birth to him, wrapped him cloths, and laid him in a manger. The child grew and became strong. Jesus increased in wisdom and in stature, and in favor with God and other men.

Day2:[Family](#) [Matthew 13:54-56](#) - He came to his hometown and began to teach the people in their synagogue, so that they were astounded and said, "Where did this man get this wisdom and power? Isn't he the carpenter's son? Is not his mother called Mary? Are not his brothers James and Joseph and Simon and Judas? And are not all his sisters with us?"

Day3:[Education](#) [Lk 2:41-46](#) - Every year his parents went to Jerusalem for Passover. And when Jesus was twelve, they went up as usual for the festival. When they started to return, he stayed behind, but his parents didn't know it. When they didn't find him, they returned to Jerusalem to search for him. After three days, they found him in the temple, sitting among the teachers, listening to them and asking them questions.

Day5:[Friendships](#) [John 15:13-15](#) - "Love each other the same way I've loved you. No one has greater love than to lay down his life for his friends. You are my friends...I don't call you my servants...I call you my friends."

Day6:[Fatigue](#) [John 4:6](#) Jesus, exhausted by his journey, rested by the well.

Day7:[Overwhelmed](#) [John 11:17,35](#) When Jesus arrived, he found that his friend Lazarus had been dead for four days. Jesus began to weep.

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
