Guiding Questions for Chapter Meetings or Solo Study:

Legacy: something from the past transmitted by or received from an ancestor or predecessor.

What legacy do you hope to leave for future generations? How is it the same as the legacy you inherited? How is it different?

How will your faith in Jesus help bridge the gap between the legacy you inherited and the one you hope to pass on?

Scripture and Quotes:

2 Tim. 4:1-8 ...I give you this charge.

Preach the word; be prepared ...correct, rebuke, and encourage with patience and careful instruction. For the time will come when people will not put up with sound teaching. Instead, to suit their own desires, they will gather around them a great number of teachers to say what their itching ears want to hear. They will turn their ears away from the truth and turn aside to myths.
