

Small Group Discussion Questions for "No Other Gospel" - Session 4

Read: Galatians 3:15 - 4:7

Summary: No one is entitled to anything from God, and no individual or group is entitled to special treatment from God. Gender, social status, and ethnic/religious identity have no bearing on our value as human beings, or what we deserve in this life. We are all recipients of his infinite mercies, and we are all of equal worth to Him.

Key Verse - Galatians 3:28

2. Give an "example from everyday life" about entitlement.
3. How did the covenant God made with Abraham change (or not change) over time? What point is Paul making here?
4. Who are the two parties the mediator is mediating for? Why is this significant?
