Today, we'll focus on three concepts of discipleship:

CONCEPT #1 - PEOPLE OVER PROGRAMS

It may seem crazy, but people can go through all the discipleship programs in the world, but never make disciples. **How is this possible?**

Discipleship doesn't happen in a classroom, it happens in everyday life, wherever God has given you access to speak into others. Where is God calling you to disciple others?

CONCEPT #2 - STARTS SMALL THEN MULTIPLY

John 6:66-69 - From this time *many of his disciples turned back* and no longer followed him. "You do not want to leave too, do you?" Jesus asked *the Twelve*. Simon Peter answered him, "Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life. We have come to believe and to know that you are the Holy One of God."

Jesus' desire is for all to be saved, yet he didn't spend all of His time preaching to the crowds. How does Jesus's (and Paul's) strategy of starting small and focusing on a few end up having the greatest kingdom impact long term?

PRINCIPLE #3 - IT'S FOR EVERYONE!

2 Corinthians 5:20 - We are therefore *Christ's ambassadors*, as though God were making his appeal through us.

We often assume it's the job of pastors to do the disciple making, yet God has chosen you to be Christ's ambassador. Who is one person that God has given you access to speak into their life? What is stopping you from discipling them?
